

ASYCUDA++ TRANSIT OPERATIONAL ON THE 4TH TRANSIT AXIS: TORGHONDI (BORDER WITH TURKMENISTAN) - HERAT - KABUL

(12 December 2007)

The ASYCUDA Transit live operations have started on the 4th transit axis, i.e. Torghondi Customs Office (border with Turkmenistan) → Herat Customs House → Kabul Customs House, on 12 December 2007, facilitating the trade and transit between Turkmenistan and Afghanistan, Iran and South Asia (Pakistan, India etc).

The system covers inland transit and is currently processing an average of 130 transit declarations per day.

An electronic transit declaration (T1) is issued for all transit cargos and an electronic message is automatically sent to the Customs Office of Destination or at the next border. The system records all reported cargos, preventing the smuggling and the loss of revenue, while facilitating the legitimate trade.

All the old documents used in Customs (e.g. ElmoKabar etc) have been abolished by the implementation of internationally standardised customs documents.
