

PILOTING OF ASYCUDA++ DPS IN KABUL CUSTOMS HOUSE

TRAINING OF CUSTOMS OFFICERS AND BROKERS

(December 2006 – January 2007)

The training of the Afghan Customs Department (ACD) staff and of the customs brokers operating in Kabul Customs House is one of the first activities of the piloting of ASYCUDA++ DPS (Declaration Processing System) in Afghanistan.

The ACD Project Team, supported by the UNCTAD/ASYCUDA Experts, have provided the ACD staff with both IT basic and ASYCUDA full functional training, and the customs brokers with the relevant ASYCUDA training. The Customs officers and the Customs brokers attended these training courses after the normal working hours.
