

**TECHNICAL MISSION ON THE EXCHANGE OF DATA
BETWEEN
THE ALBANIAN AND MACEDONIAN CUSTOMS ADMINISTRATIONS**

(March 2006)

A technical mission on the exchange of data between the Albanian and the Macedonian Customs Administrations for operational purposes (pre-arrival information) was hosted by the Macedonian Customs (MCA) in its new premises in Skopje.
