

**TRILATERAL TECHNICAL MEETING  
OF THE STATE CUSTOMS COMMITTEE OF THE AZERBAIJAN REPUBLIC,  
THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE OF GEORGIA AND  
THE UNCTAD/ASYCUDA PROGRAMME  
ON THE EXCHANGE OF CUSTOMS PRE-ARRIVAL DATA  
BETWEEN AZERBAIJAN AND THE STATE REVENUE SERVICE OF GEORGIA**

(Baku, 05-06 June 2008)

The State Customs Committee (SCC) of the Azerbaijan Republic kindly hosted a two-day trilateral technical meeting on the exchange of Customs pre-arrival data between Azerbaijan and Georgia.

The meeting was chaired by Mr. A. Aliyev, Head of SCC Statistics & IT Department.

The other participants in this meeting were the representatives of the IT Department in the Ministry of Finance (MOF) of Georgia and of the UNCTAD/ASYCUDA Program.

The technical solutions identified for the automatic exchange of electronic data between the SCC CIS (Customs Information System) and the ASYCUDAWorld system of the MOF/State Revenue Service (SRS) in Georgia will be consolidated in the document that will be submitted for consideration and approval to the SCC and SRS top-management.

The representatives of the UNCTAD/ASYCUDA Programme highly appreciated the open and professional discussions, and the commitment of all parties to produce tangible short-term results for the benefit of both SCC and MOF/SRS, and finally Azerbaijan and Georgia.
