

EXECUTIVE TRAINING WORKSHOP ON ELECTRONIC GOVERNMENT

(Tirana, 22 April 2009)

The Executive Training Workshop on Electronic Government was organized by the Centre for e-Governance Program@SEE, in the Tirana International Hotel conference centre.

Participants: policy makers, executive members of governmental institutions and organisations, and other private/public sector experts.

Representatives of the Ministry of Finance (Tax Department, Customs Department, Treasury), the Ministry of Transport (General Road Department), the Electronic Procurement Department, the Department of Public Administration, the Office for Combating and Prevention of Money Laundering have presented the current status of their projects in the framework of e-Government.

- e-Government initiatives and Lighthouse Project in the region;
- Introduction to Electronic Government & Developments in the European Union
- e-Government Interoperability: Standards and Frameworks;
- Managing electronic ID's;
- Designing and implementing key eGov projects;
- Transforming Governmental Services for Citizens and Businesses.



The Albanian Customs representative and the UNCTAD Senior Customs Adviser have provided the meeting with an overview of the ASYCUDAWorld eCustoms Project and its current status of implementation.

The presentation was followed by a demo of the ASYCUDAWorld' Single Window capabilities and its practical application to support the effective cooperation between border control agencies (IBM, Integrated Border Management).

The direct result in all border control agencies is a joint approach to risk-management and a significantly increased efficiency of profiling, selectivity, targeting activities.
