

ASYCUDA RISK-MANAGEMENT SEMINAR ORGANISED BY THE GEORGIAN STATE REVENUE SERVICE

(Tbilisi, 14 February 2007)

The Georgian Revenue Service (SRS) has organised a seminar on the “Introduction of the ASYCUDA Risk Management/Selectivity in the Western part of Georgia”, on 14 February 2008 in the premises of the USAID/Business Climate Reform Project (BCRP).

The seminar followed the launch in live operation of the ASYCUDA Risk Management /Selectivity in the following customs offices in the Western region of Georgia: Adlia, Batumi Port, Poti Port and Kutaisi Service Center.



Thus, the ASYCUDA Risk Management /Selectivity System is operational nationwide.

The subject of the seminar was (1) Introduction of the ASYCUDA Risk Management /Selectivity in the operational Customs environment and (2) Introduction of the Simplified Customs Procedures.

The quality of the presentations made by the SRS Risk-Analysis Unit (RAU) as well as the questions & answers sessions were highly appreciated by the representatives of the Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Economic Development, USAID and AMCHAM (American Chamber of Commerce) participating in the meeting.
