

ASYCUDAWORLD IN SYRIA

In an effort to streamline and harmonize the customs procedures, the Government of Syria selected ASYCUDAWorld as a tool for the automation of Customs.

The ASYCUDAWorld system to be implemented in Republic of SYRIA is based on state of the art IT technologies (web, Java etc) and could be one of the core elements of the implementation of e-government and e-business in the country.

The project, financed by the Government of the Arab Republic of Syria and United Nations Development Program, will last 24 months.

UNCTAD will be responsible for the execution and the implementation of the Customs Procedures Automation and will closely cooperate with the UNDP office in Damascus responsible for the Capacity Building and Infrastructure components of the project.
